

MCF Meeting Covid-19 Precautions

Getting Covid-19 could be life threatening for some people. In times like these, there are differences of opinion and behavior, so achieving compliance with these guidelines may be difficult. Please, let's honor Jesus Christ and each other by considering our neighbors' health concerns, and in love, follow these guidelines to the best of our wisdom.

Kindly observe the following guidelines, please:

Individual attendees:

- A. No one should attend who has tested positive for Covid-19 virus, unless they have subsequently tested negative.
- B. No one should attend who has a cough, fever, loss of taste or smell, or cold and flu-like symptoms, (sneezing, congestion, body aches, or gastrointestinal upset.) If feeling ill, please, stay home.
- C. The elderly 65 years or older, and any other persons with health risks ought to consider staying home. (Risk factors include diabetes; high blood pressure; heart, lung, or kidney problems; or taking medicines that reduce immunity.) Although Covid is less dangerous for younger people in good health, some risk remains for them, too. Please do not attend if you feel it to be too risky for yourself or family.
- D. Wash your hands thoroughly with soap and water before arrival, and after you leave. Please, don't be a potential Covid conduit to those at home who may be at risk.
- E. Distancing: Please do not hug, nor shake hands. Instead, give a friendly thumbs up. Follow the seating area spacing, (see below.)
- F. Social conversations before and after the meeting should be done outside as weather permits. Maintain at least six feet of separation from others with whom you did not come. G. Wear a face mask if you desire to take extra precautions.
- H. Please use the hands-free sanitizer dispensers at both main entrances.
- I. For your hygiene, each restroom has a hands-free soap dispenser.
- J. Bring your own pen/pencil for personal use. Avoid sharing it.

Other general precautions being taken:

- A. All doors will be propped open for maximum auditorium ventilation.
- B. Donations will be collected in a container at a check in table before the meeting. No donation plates or pouches will be passed around during the meeting.
- C. Seating area spacing: Do not move the chairs around. Individuals or groups must leave at least two empty chairs (about 6 feet) between themselves and others. For seating purposes, groups may be defined as families, or those who have arrived in one vehicle. D. No unison singing or recitation will be allowed indoors.
